The Muckamore Abbey Hospital Public Inquiry is a big investigation. It is ordered by the government and must happen by law.



It will look into the abuse of patients at Muckamore Abbey Hospital.

Abuse is when someone hurts you or treats you badly.



The inquiry will

- find out why abuse happened
- and find out how abuse was allowed to happen.

It will do this to help stop such abuse happening again.








9. Write one or two sentences about what kind of information you have to give us.
