## **UNDERTAKING**

This is an undertaking in respect of any person who provides evidence to the Muckamore Abbey Hospital Inquiry ('the Inquiry').

- 1. No oral evidence given by a natural person before the Inquiry will be used in evidence against that person in any criminal proceedings or for the purpose of deciding whether to bring such proceedings save as provided in paragraph 3 herein.
- 2. No written statement drafted for the purpose of giving evidence to the Inquiry by or for such a person identified at paragraph 1. will be used in evidence against that person in any criminal proceedings or for the purpose of deciding whether to bring such proceedings save as provided in paragraph 3 herein. This shall include any statement made by or for such a person for that purpose preparatory to giving evidence to the Inquiry or during the course of their testimony to the Inquiry.
- 3. Paragraphs 1. and 2. do not apply to:
- (a) a prosecution in which that person is charged with having given false evidence in the course of this Inquiry or having conspired with or procured others to do so, or
- (b) a prosecution in which that person is charged with any offence under section 35 of the Inquiries Act 2005 or with having conspired with or procured others to commit such an offence.
