2	FOLLOWS:

4	CHAIRPERSON: Good morning, everybody, and I hope	
5	everybody has been given some warning that we have got 10:	: 00
6	problems today. The position is this: There is a	
7	registered intermediary who has been working with both	
8	the witnesses that we were going to have today, this	
9	morning and this afternoon's witness, and,	
10	unfortunately, he contacted the Inquiry this morning at $_{10}$:	:00
11	about 8:30 to inform us that he has tested positive for	
12	Covid.	
13		
14	We have made attempts to find an alternative RI -	
15	that's not always best practice in any event, but we	: 00
16	wanted to see what we could do, and, in fact,	
17	unfortunately, no other RI is available.	
18		
19	I have taken the decision, therefore, that even if the	
20	witness wanted to, and I'm not sure he does, we ought 10:	:00
21	not to proceed today, having recognised that these are	
22	vulnerable witnesses and they need an RI, then that's	
23	how we ought to proceed. So can I apologise to	
24	everybody. Obviously it's not the Inquiry's fault, nor	
25	is it the RI's fault, but my decision is that we have 10:	: 01
26	to adjourn today.	
27		
28	Could I just mention tomorrow? Obviously we will	
29	reschedule these two witnesses and give everybody as	

1	much notice as we can.	
2		
3	So far as tomorrow is concerned, tomorrow is the day	
4	that we have the witness who has the phobia of masks.	
5	Could I ask anybody who wants to wear a mask - and if	10:01
6	this could be repeated to any CPs who are attending -	
7	should sit in Room B - when the witness is brought up	
8	into the main public area she will be with Inquiry	
9	staff, so please could you be alert and if asked to	
10	move by Inquiry staff, please could you do so promptly.	10:01
11	And obviously not have masks with you in the public	
12	area in sight of the witness. That witness will be	
13	giving evidence I think in the morning, but in any	
14	event, she will be here all day tomorrow, so I am	
15	afraid that applies throughout the day. Please be very	10:02
16	conscious of that. There's nothing else I think is	
17	there, Mr. Doran?	
18	MR. DORAN: No, Chair. Can I jus say that I've spoken	
19	to the witness who was scheduled to give evidence this	
20	morning, and he understands the position fully and I	10:02
21	have assured him that his evidence will be rescheduled	
22	for October.	
23	CHAIRPERSON: Right. Well, I am sure there's plenty of	
24	work that people can do today, but apologies that the	
25	Inquiry can't sit. So we'll adjourn until tomorrow at	10:02
26	10:00 o'clock. Thank you very much.
