Hearings Update



Hearings are meetings where we listen to evidence.

The Inquiry has now heard a lot of **evidence** about

- learning disability and mental health laws
- rules about how staff should do things
- staff job roles
- and how decisions were made.

Some people who have already given evidence to us will be asked to give more.

Evidence is anything that you see, experience, read, or are told that helps us find out what happened.



We are now looking at evidence about hospital reports and how the hospital was run.

More work needs to be done before we hear more evidence.
